Tmt.S.Sangeetha, Typist, City Civil Court, Chennai, has not completed the Certificate Course on Computer on Office Automation but she has been declared probation erroneously on the A.N. of 24.04.2016 vide Proceedings cited 1st in the reference. She has completed the Certificate Course on Computer on Office Automation on 24.04.2022 only. Hence, the letter has been addressed to the Hon'ble High Court, Madras, vide reference 4th cited, to solicit instructions in this matter.

In this regard, the Official Memorandum cited 5th in the reference, has been received from the Hon'ble High Court, Madras, stating that the Principal District Judge, Tiruvannamalai, is directed to cancel the proceedings cited 1st in the reference, by which the individual was declared to have satisfactorily completed her Probation Period. It is further stating that the Principal Judge, City Civil Court, Chennai, is directed to re-declare the Probation of the individual as per rules and to recover the monetary benefits paid to which she is not entitled for and it is further stating that before initiating such recovery proceedings, the individual should be duly informed regarding the same.

In pursuance to the directions given by the Hon'ble High Court, Madras, vide Official Memorandum cited 5th in the reference, the Proceedings of the Principal District

Judge, Tiruvannamalai, cited 1st in the reference, regarding declaration of probation was cancelled vide Proceedings of the Principal District Judge, Tiruvannamalai District, vide reference 6th cited.

Hence, the Probation of the individual is **re-declared on the F.N. of 25.04.2022 in the post of Typist** i.e., the day following the last date of examination (i.e.24.04.2022) of Certificate Course in Computer on Office Automation conducted by Directorate of Technical Education.
