The above individuals are placed under probation for a period of two years with in a continuous period of three years. But, before that their services have to be regularised. Since the probation commences only from the date of their regular appointment.

The above said individuals are placed under probation for a period of Two years within a continuous period of 3 years from the date mentioned in Col.No.4 as specified under Rule 27 of the T.N.J.M.S. Rules.
