

ORDER:

Thiru.P.Sethuraman while working as Examiner, Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Madurai died in harness on 19.02.2018. His son Thiru.S.Makesh applied for the post of Junior Assistant in the Tamil Nadu Judicial Ministerial Service on compassionate grounds. The date of birth of Thiru.S.Makesh is 23.02.1997. He has passed S.S.L.C., He is thus eligible for appointment as Junior Assistant in the Tamil Nadu Judicial Ministerial Service. He was therefore appointed temporarily as Junior Assistant in the Sub Court, Madurai and joined duty on the Forenoon of 05.07.2018. The Registrar (District Judiciary), High Court of Madras, has sent proposal for regularisation of the services of the above individual as Junior Assistant in the Tamil Nadu Judicial Ministerial Service with effect from 05.07.2018 F.N.

- 2. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Registrar (District Judiciary) High Court of Madras, Chennal and verified all the original certificates of the individual regarding the appointment in the post of Junior Assistant on compassionate grounds. Accordingly, the Government direct that the services of Thiru.S.Makesh, 5/0 Late Thiru.P.Sethuraman, formerly Examiner, Chief Judicial Magistrate court, Madurai appointed on compassionate grounds be regularised in the post of Junior Assistant under the Tamil Nadu Judicial Ministerial Service in the Sub Court, Madurai with effect from 05.07.2018 F.N. subject to the condition that the individual should possesses the physical fitness to hold the post in which he is regularized and ordered accordingly. In view of the retrospective regularisation, the individual is eligible to draw the annual increments and arrears of pay and allowances if any, as per the rules.
